I assume you are referring to a full machine? With our dedicated machines we offer full access if you prefer (SSH, RDP) or we can install TCAdmin for server management.

40GB Per day over 12 servers would equate to 1200GB over 30 days, I don't understand why you were removed from a provider for this amount of transfer? Our servers come with 2000GB gaming transfer, obviously if you are hosting websites on there as well it would up the amount you are using but I would assume you would still fall beneath this.

10GB a day for a gaming community is quite impressive, are you hosting videos or something here?
